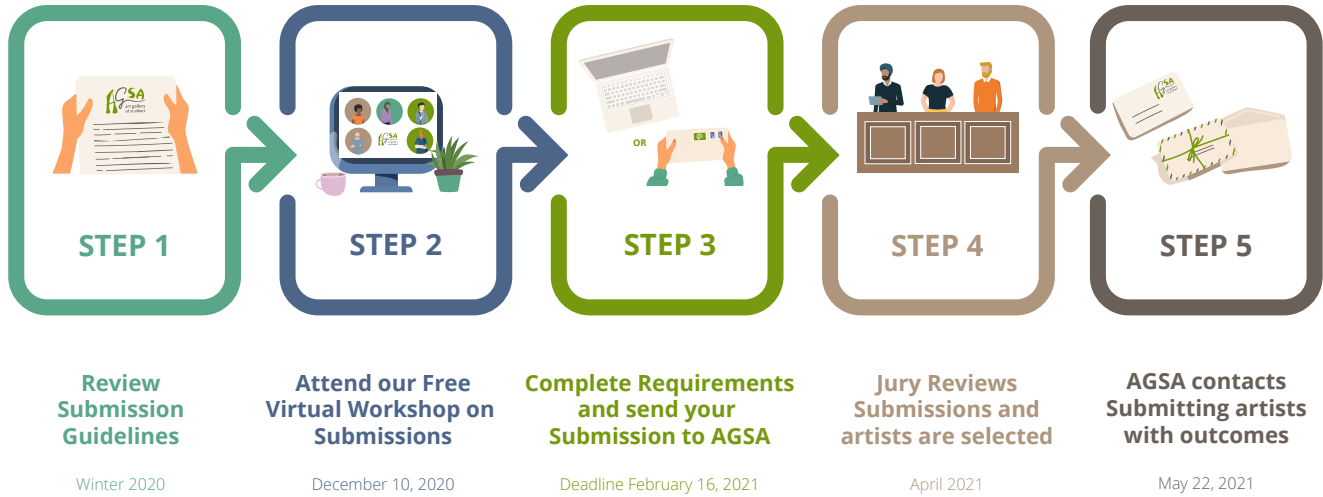


# Application Form | Call for Submissions | 2022

## Important information:

- Artists submitting via dropbox must contact [exhibitions@artsandheritage.ca](mailto:exhibitions@artsandheritage.ca) for an upload link no later than 4 PM on Monday February 15, 2021.
- Artists sending their submission in the mail will need to include all of the requested files on a CD, DVD or USB device. Submissions can be mailed c/o Exhibitions Assistant, Art Gallery of St. Albert, 19 Perron Street, St. Albert, AB, T8N 1E5.
- Artists submitting in person, or through the mail will need to provide a self-addressed and stamped envelope if they would like their submission returned after the jury.

## File formatting:

- All digital copies of written documents must be sent as .pdf files.
- All digital images must be sent as .jpg files.
- All video and sound files must be PC compatible, and no longer than 6 minutes per submission.
- **NEW:** Vimeo and YouTube links are accepted, but are also limited to 6-minutes per submission

## Main Exhibition Gallery:

- Completed application form (a scan or photo is acceptable)
- Exhibition description/proposal (max 500 words)
- CV/ Artist's Résumé (max 3 pages)
- Artist Statement (max 500 words)
- Up to 10 high quality images (JPG format)
- Corresponding image list (title, medium, year of creation, framed dimensions H x W x D and corresponding image file name for each piece)

Submissions for the Main Gallery can be sent via dropbox, in person or through the mail.

## Feature Spaces submission requirements (AGSA vault or staircase):

- Completed application form
- Up to 5 high quality images (JPG format)
- Corresponding image list (title, medium, year of creation, framed dimensions H x W x D, and weight)
- Description of the work or project- including the main themes, and artistic media (max 200 words)

Submissions for the Feature Spaces can be sent via dropbox, in person, or through the mail.
