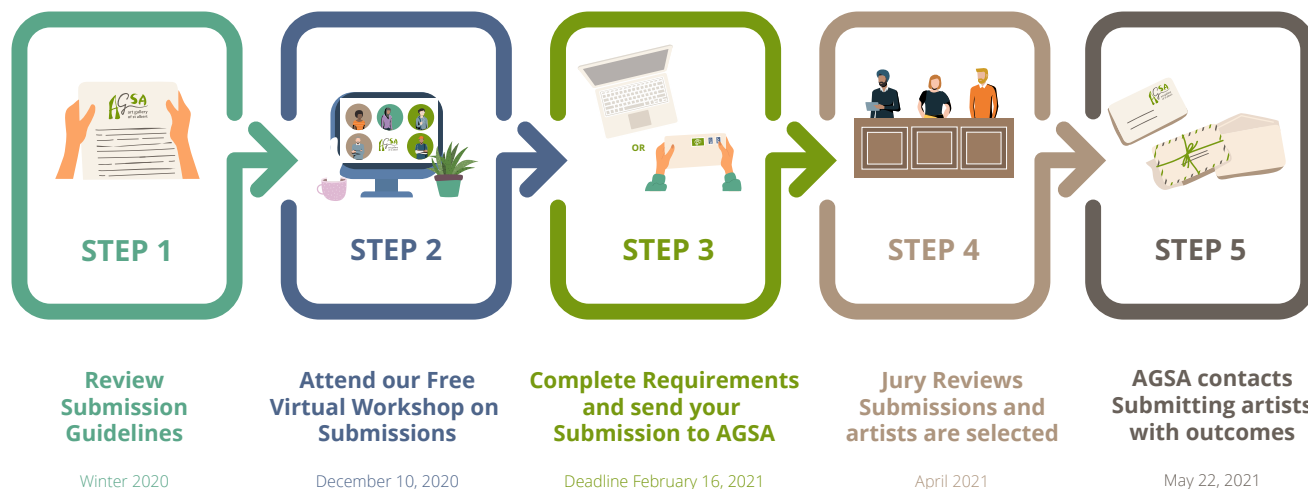


Staircase Exhibition Space | Call for Submissions 2022

Art Gallery of St. Albert has a beautiful staircase gallery on which we showcase large 2-dimensional works, or ceiling suspended sculptures. Visitors experience this space as they travel to the main exhibitions gallery on the second floor.

Pop in any time during our open hours to see the space.

- Art comes in all shapes and sizes, but the staircase space is not well suited for works that require up-close viewing or complex lighting
- The space can accommodate up to 3 large wall hanging pieces (maximum of 60x40" each).
- Suspended sculptures can be a maximum of 36" wide, 30" deep and 72" in height. The maximum weight is 30 lbs.
- We offer a CARFAC (Canadian Artists Representation/ le Front des Artistes Canadian) fee of \$565 (single artwork fee)



All submissions for an exhibition in our feature staircase space must contain:

1. Completed Application Form
2. Up to 5 Digital Images demonstrating proposed, in-progress or recent work.
3. Corresponding Image List including title, medium, year of creation and dimensions
4. A short description of the work or project- including the main themes, media, and size. (Max 200 words)

Artists may send their submissions to the Art Gallery of St. Albert through the mail, in person, or through Dropbox. Submission deadline is Tuesday February 16, 2021.

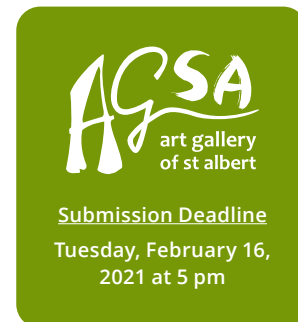
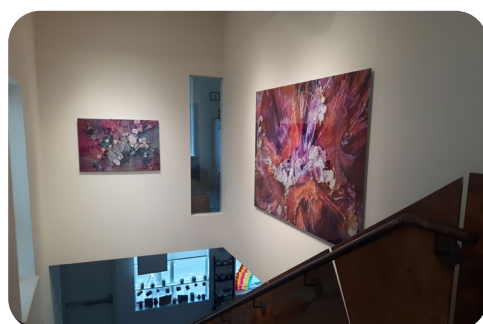
