

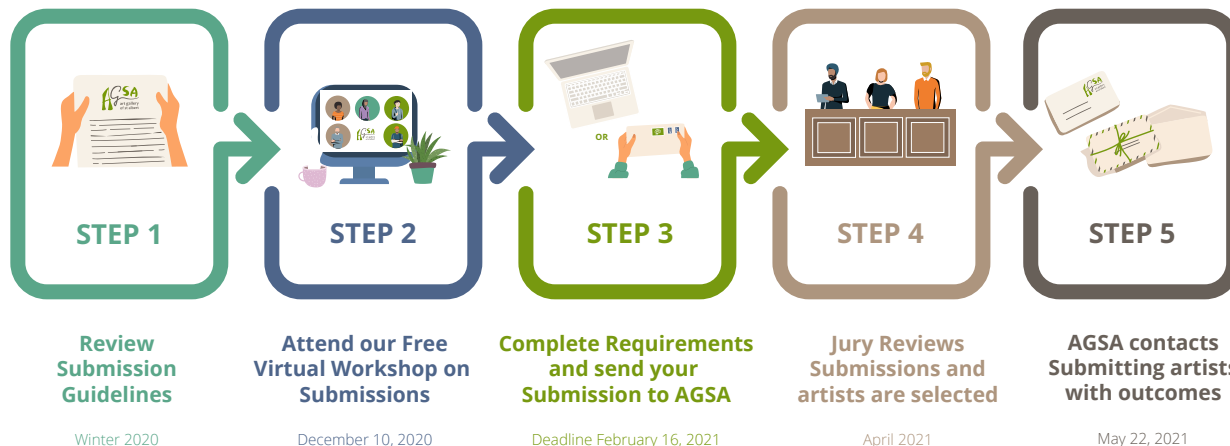
Art Gallery of St. Albert's call for submissions for 2022 exhibition year is open!

Art Gallery of St. Albert (AGSA), a contemporary public art gallery, is seeking submissions from artists, artist groups, or curators of all artistic and cultural backgrounds working in all styles and mediums for exhibition in the 2022 calendar year.

The Gallery strives to provide a thought-provoking exhibition schedule and corresponding programs that support educationally challenging art and appeal to many audiences. AGSA is dedicated to curating a diverse exhibition year, profiling a wide range of artists, styles and mediums.

The Gallery strives to be accessible and inclusive. We encourage artists to contact exhibitions@artsandheritage.ca if they have any questions or concerns regarding our submission requirements. We are happy to work collaboratively with artists to make alternative arrangements.

Artists may send their submissions to the Gallery through Dropbox, in person or through the mail. Submissions are adjudicated by a panel of visual art professionals who represent a spectrum of expertise in the visual arts. The artists chosen to exhibit receive Canadian Artists Representation/le Front des Artistes Canadian (CARFAC) exhibition fees.



Important Information:

- Artists submitting via dropbox must contact exhibitions@artsandheritage.ca for an upload link no later than 4 pm (MST) on Monday February 15, 2021.
- Artists sending their submission in the mail will need to include all requested files on a CD, DVD or USB device. Submissions can be mailed c/o Exhibitions Assistant, Art Gallery of St. Albert, 19 Perron Street, St. Albert, AB, T8N 1E5.
- Artists submitting in person, or through the mail should provide a self-addressed and stamped envelope if they would like their hardcopy submission returned after the jury.

File Formatting:

- All written documents must be sent as .pdf files.
- All digital images must be sent as .jpg files.
- All video and sound files must be PC compatible, and no longer than 6 minutes per submission.
- NEW: Vimeo and YouTube links are accepted, but are also limited to 6-minutes per submission.

Final Notes:

- Submissions will only be accepted if the above requirements are met
- Deadline for submissions: Tuesday February 16, 2021, 5 pm
- All applicants will be contacted by Saturday, May 22, 2021
- Artists may be selected for either solo exhibitions or group exhibitions with compatible artworks
 - Please clearly indicate if a submission is intended for a solo exhibition only
